MASTER OF ARTS IN SUSTAINABLE URBANISM

Educating the next generation of architects and designers to meet the challenges of urbanisation.

Our course is an established two-year full time programme in Sustainable Architecture & Urbanism, carrying an MA in **SUSTAINABLE URBANISM** from the University of Wales.

Starting every July, we host the first year of the course at our Shoreditch office in London. And, depending on the student's ability, the second year is a placement with one of our partners in the UK, during which they complete a dissertation.

Our course blends academic research and practical placements, forming a bridge between education and work.

WHO CAN APPLY?

We welcome applications from EU students. All we ask is that they are fluent in English (IELTS 7.0) and have completed a first degree (or Part I) in any of the following:

Non-native English speakers who have not completed a previous degree course taught in English will need to provide an IELTS certificate with a score of 7.0 or higher.
