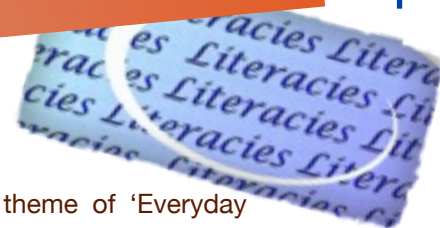

This conference will offer keynote presentations and seminars around the theme of 'Everyday Language & Literacies'. The focus will be upon literacies as they are practised in everyday life, embedded in social contexts. We welcome papers which understand literacy in its broadest sense and as a social practice. Literacies may be defined as local, global, multilingual, ephemeral, material, immaterial, formal or informal, virtual, liturgical, multimodal (etc). The conference will celebrate literacy as a diverse pluralised concept. Local, community and domestic practices are likely to be to the fore, with an emphasis on how literacy is embedded in particular everyday identities. Papers may or may not make reference to implications for policy.
