SCRAMx® is the only device available in the UK that continually monitors a person for alcohol use, covering an entire 24 hour period.

Until now most alcohol testing focuses on point in time and past alcohol use. These methods can indicate whether a person has consumed alcohol at some point in the last few hours, days or weeks, but cannot show where a drinking episode started or finished.

99% Sober Days™ using SCRAMx®

A Sober Day™ can be defined as a 24-hour period in which a monitored individual has no confirmed consumption of alcohol and no confirmed attempt to tamper or circumvent with testing in order to mask the consumption of alcohol.

Based on usage of the device in the U.S., the average daily participant compliance rate is over 99%, meaning that 99 out of every 100 participants on any given day did not drink or tamper while being monitored by SCRAMx®. Since 2003, the ankle bracelet has been used to monitor over 240,000 participants, completing over 21.3 million monitored days, with approximately 21 million defined as sober days.

SCRAMx® works by testing for alcohol transdermally (through the skin) every 30 minutes using a bracelet worn on the ankle.



SCRAMx® continuously collects and stores data to be uploaded to our secure portal called SCRAMnet™ for analysis and reporting.
