GUIDELINES

A normal Symposium

- is designed to be a focused session in which speakers present a common theme, issue or question.
- would usually consist of a chairperson briefly introducing the topic and providing an introduction to the session. This would be followed by 4 to 5 individual speakers (ideally from 3 different affiliations or countries), and possibly ending with concluding remarks by a discussant. There should be opportunity for audience members to ask questions to presenters and for an exchange of views.
- will run for 90 minutes.
- > shall be proposed either in **English or in French** (for inclusion in the French speaking program). Speakers presenting in a French Symposium will have to submit an abstract in English and will have to prepare slides in English.

NEW! The open symposium concept:

- You see the organisation of a symposium as a good opportunity to meet people working on the same topic as you?
- You tried to organise a symposium on a key and topical subject, but you could not gather the 5 required presentations?
- You wonder if a theoretical discussion including different perspectives on an emerging theme would be of current interest? **This concept is for you!**

How to proceed-?

Contrary to a traditional symposium, at least two persons can submit an open symposium.

- 1. One of these persons, the **organiser**, is required to submit a description of the symposium project (topic and presentations' details) **no later than 15 November 2013** on the congress website: http://www.icap2014.com/call-for-open-symposia/open-symposia-submission/97
- Each complementary speaker should submit his/her abstract before 1 December 2013 on the congress website: http://www.icap2014.com/call-for-individual-papers-and-posters/68 by selecting the type of presentation "open symposium" and by indicating the symposium

- **reference number** (obtained by the organiser at the end of the submission, ex- ICAP2014-SPXXXX).
- 3. Once submitted, the open symposium proposal and its related abstracts will be published on the congress website: http://www.icap2014.com/call-for-open-symposia/open-symposia-proposals/96 (weekly update)
- 4. Somewhere in the world, a researcher qualified in the same field will see the suggested topic. He/She should then submit his/her abstract **before 1 December 2013** on the congress website http://www.icap2014.com/call-for-individual-papers-and-posters/68 by indicating the symposium reference number (available on the Congress Website)

Evaluation procedure

The open symposium will be evaluated by the scientific committee.

- ➤ **If rejected,** submitted abstracts will be considered as individual papers and will be reevaluated in January 2014.
- ➤ **If accepted**, submitted abstracts will be associated to the referenced symposium.
 - o After this evaluation, if 5 abstracts receive approval, the symposium will be accepted and considered as the other symposia.
 - o **If less than 5 abstracts are submitted,** the symposium will be rejected, and the submitted abstracts will be considered as individual papers.
 - o If more than 5 abstracts receive approval, the experts will keep the 5 best ones. From this point of view, matching the symposium topic will be an important criterion. Submitted abstracts for symposia that will be rejected despite a positive evaluation will be considered as individual papers.
 - The symposium organiser and authors will be notified as soon as possible, and before
 6 December, whether their project has been accepted.

Submission procedure:

Submissions are to be made exclusively electronically via the congress website www.icap2014.com Submissions by email, surface mail or fax will not be accepted for review.

Submission conditions:

By submitting a symposium:

- You grant the Organizing Committee permission to publish the abstract in the Congress Handbook in hard copy and electronic format;
- You grant a non-exclusive right to publish, reproduce, distribute, display and store the
 abstract worldwide in all forms, formats and media now known or as developed in the
 future, including print, electronic and digital forms. You will retain copyright of your abstract,
 in addition to the moral rights you are entitled to as author of the abstract;
- You grant permission for your presentation to be audio/video recorded and hereby grant to
 the Congress a non-exclusive right to reproduce or display and store the recorded material
 for the purpose of providing Professional Development either by download from the ICAP or
 the hosts websites or via distribution of a CD/DVD;
- You grant permission for the PDF of your presentation to be made available online to all conference delegates following the congress.

Instructions for the preparation of your symposium proposal:

- The symposium summary cannot contain more than 3500 characters (Blank spaces and punctuation are included. Title and authors' list & affiliation are not included). The minimum size is 2000 characters.
- The structure of your proposal should be as follows:
 - o Title of the symposium
 - List of authors (including the symposium organizer as first author)
 - Introduction & objectives of the Symposium (2000 characters, spaces included)
 - Preliminary program of the symposium including-:
 Speakers presentation titles, full names, affiliations, cities and countries (about 250 characters, spaces included, each)
- It is not possible to insert tables or images.
- Abbreviations may be used after defining them first.

Technical guidelines:

- The symposium submission website works best with Mozilla Firefox:
 - o Cookies need to be enabled
 - o All pop-up blockers should be turned off
- If you have successfully submitted your symposium, you will receive a confirmation number. If no confirmation number is received, the symposium has not been successfully submitted.
