Special Programs

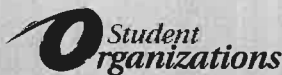
Student Activities collectively participates in numerous special programs throughout the year. These initiatives foster a spirit of tradition and community and often involve campus-wide partners.

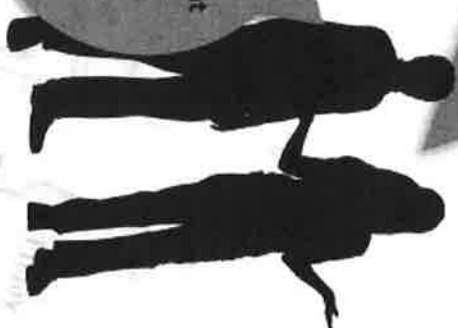
Alcohol and Events: University Alcohol Policy

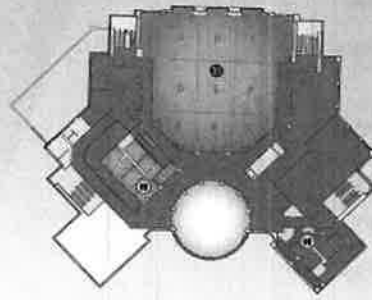

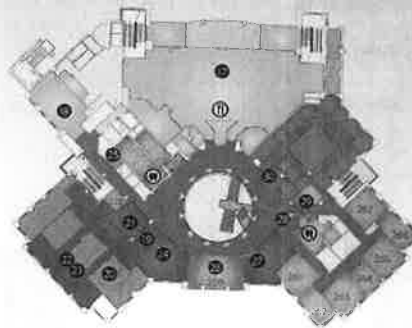
Student Government & Organizations Complex (SGOC)

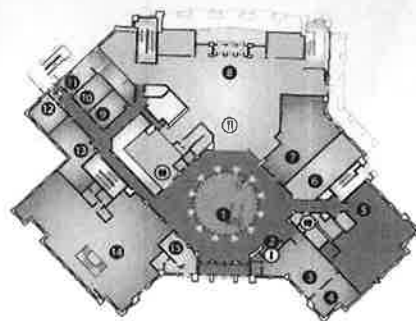
