

Saturday 28 June: Optional Study visit to Summerlee Museum of Scottish Industrial Life, in Coatbridge, North Lanarkshire

Thinking of extending your visit to the Glasgow area after the conference?

A group of delegates are planning to stay on after the conference to visit Summerlee, to discover more about Scotland's industrial heritage and meet Curator Jenny Noble for an introduction to the site and behind the scenes tour including a look at the stores (capacity permitting).

A limited number of en-suite rooms have been booked at Strathclyde University accommodation on the Friday evening to facilitate delegates wanting to join this visit the following day.

Summerlee is free to enter, but as this is not part of the conference package delegates will need to pay their own transport costs on public transport from Glasgow.

Trains run approx every 15 mins from Glasgow Queen St to Coatbridge Sunnyside - the journey takes around 20 mins and costs less than £5 return
