

Travelling to SHCG Conference 2014

We advise delegates to book their travel as early as possible to ensure the best deal on fares. Please read the following information below before booking your travel.

Day 1 of the Conference is at the Riverside Museum, Glasgow and Day Two is at the National Mining Museum, Scotland, Newtongrange

Day 1: The Riverside Museum

Is a short bus, train or subway ride away from Glasgow City Centre. The nearest Subway and Train Station to the Riverside Museum is Patrick Street (7 minutes walk). The 100 Riversider Bus departs from the City Centre every 30 minutes. For more information visit:

Delegates will need to make their own way from the City Centre or Airport to the Riverside Museum for the start of Day 1. However, a coach will take delegates from the Riverside Museum at the end of Day 1 to the accommodation at the University of Strathclyde Campus Village and evening activity venue, the Tenement Museum.

Day 2: The National Mining Museum, Scotland

A coach will take all delegates staying in accommodation at Campus Village to the National Mining Museum, Scotland, our Day 2 venue. Those staying at other accommodation in the city centre are welcome to join the rest of the group to catch the coach from the accommodation at approx. 8.30am (time tbc in final delegate information). The National Mining Museum is about 1h 15 minutes from Glasgow by road and 30 minutes away from Edinburgh.
