#### AIM

The aim of this conference is to vocalise, discuss and work through many of the topical issues of conducting a practice-based PhD in Design. It will enable early career design researchers to explore a variety of aspects of knowledge production within an academic institution. A secondary aim of the conference is to share questions that emerge through doing practicebased research.

What counts as practice-based research? + What are the politics of designing and conducting practice-based research? + Where are the boundaries of theory & practice? + How can we make practice-based research accountable?

This two day event will include twelve discussion sessions, presentations from leading design researchers and a public lecture by Professor Bill Gaver. The conference is an opportunity to come together to share practices, experiences and provide a forum to build a practice-based design research community.

#### HOW TO GET INVOLVED

We ask you to submit three questions that relate to issues you are discovering within your practice-based research. One question relating to doing/making/planning, the second to output/dissemination/use and the third we are leaving open for you to decide. These questions will be used to group you into seminar sessions that will run throughout the event.

#### Some example questions might be:

How to plan and develop your practice within the research process? • How to think about measuring the impact of design research? • What is the political economy of design research? • How do we deal with the politics of design research?

We ask you to bring with you a 5 minute presentation describing your practice-based research.
