Women's Support Project, in conjunction with Glasgow Film Theatre, present a Screen Debate to mark September as Month of Action to raise awareness of childhood sexual abuse.

After Saville: No More Secrets? and *Saville: The Power to Abuse*, are hard hitting BBC documentaries highlighting the Saville child abuse scandal which spanned decades. These programmes explore how well known public figures were able to access vulnerable children, and why they were able to continue to abuse with impunity. The documentaries include interviews with survivors, police and senior figures within institutions.

The screening will be followed by a panel and audience discussion, which will explore issues from the films and debate whether things have changed or if such abuse could be happening today.
