

## Poster Presentations

During the event we will provide time for participants to share their own peer led academic learning models, projects, good practice, innovation and/or research in the format of a poster. There will be allocated time for everyone to view posters and have discussions.

The possibilities are wide open. We would like to hear about:

- Your Peer led academic learning programme and how it is structured
- Particular aspects of your work that you are especially enthusiastic about, and want to share
- Projects or initiatives where you would like to share ideas and get feedback
- Research, including accounts of research in progress
- Posters about themes or concepts that you are exploring
- Student perspectives, including posters by students about their experience of student engagement
- Any aspect of your work where you are keen to share ideas and build links with colleagues at other universities or colleges.

**The main restriction is the size of the poster. The maximum size is A1 (portrait) and A2 (landscape). There is no restriction on content or format.** The posters can range from:

- o Professionally designed to freehand work
- o Mainly text to mainly image-based
- o Monochrome to multi-coloured
