Getting to Liverpool

If you haven't already made travel plans then here's some help!

By Air

Liverpool's John Lennon Airport offers access from over 50 UK and European destinations and is only 10 kms from the city centre. Bus 500 takes you to the city centre every 30 minutes; a taxi ride takes 20 minutes.

From Manchester International Airport there is a direct 1 hour rail link to Liverpool city centre, or by taxi it's approximately 45 minutes. www.manchesterairport.co.uk

By Rail

The closest station is Liverpool Lime Street, only a 15 minute walk from the BT ACC conference centre. www.virgintrains.co.uk or www.thetrainline.com

By Car

On SatNav it's L3 4BX on Queens Wharf, Liverpool. Whichever direction you approach the city from, follow the brown tourist route signs for the Waterfront. There is extensive 24 hour parking at the Liverpool Waterfront Car Park.

By Bicycle

If you're keen, BT ACC Liverpool has its own secure cycle parking, and most stations have free, secure cycle storage too. It's free to take your bike on ferries and trains in Merseyside.


