

ADI Research Grant for Development Studies Asia Development Institute, Seoul National University, Republic of Korea

The Asia Development Institute of Seoul National University invites academics and experts including doctoral and postdoctoral students to apply for the ADI Research Grant. The ADI Research Grant aims to support those who intend to undertake research in Korea for a short period of time (within two weeks) in the field of development studies and public policy broadly understood that addresses substantive concerns and issues related to national development in the developing world. We are especially interested in scholars whose work focuses on the Korean experience either in the form of case study or comparative research.

The Fellowship Grant

The fellowship will cover up economy class round trip ticket and research grant \$3,200 which will cover travel insurance, accommodation, and the expense for field research in Korea. The recipient will be provided an office at Seoul National University, and will be invited to participate in the academic activities of the Asia Development Institute.

Responsibilities

The fellow will be expected to: (1) give a presentation of research at the ADI and (2) submit a report of the field research (3) to publish academic paper(s) acknowledging the ADI support. The field research should take place by the end of February 2015.
