





## **Ideal Candidate Profile**

### **Academic Background:**

- A Postgraduate degree (at least a Master's degree) in statistics or economics.
- Knowledge of a range of cross-national household and child surveys (content and methodology) would be an advantage.
- Knowledge of economic and social statistics and experience with econometric analysis would be an advantage.

### **Professional Background:**

- Experience of undertaking secondary analysis of large-scale cross-national datasets.
- Experience with family policy and child well-being statistics, preferably acquired in a national administration or in an international organisation, would be an advantage.
- Experience in the preparation of statistical documents and reports.
- Ability to draft technical notes, documentation and correspondence relating to statistical matters.
- Good organisational skills and ability to adapt rapidly to new tasks.

### **Tools:**

- Experience in the use of modern statistical information technology, especially for electronic data collection, verification and analysis. Familiarity with software used by OECD (such as Excel, Access) would be a necessity while working knowledge of one of these common statistical softwares (STATA, SPSS or SAS) is also essential.

### **Communication and Languages:**

- Good communication and interpersonal skills; good team worker. Ability to work in a multicultural environment under general instructions. Ability to maintain effective working relations with other staff and persons outside of the Organisation.
- Very good spoken and written knowledge of one of the two official languages of the Organisation (English and French). Working knowledge of the other would be an advantage.
- Knowledge of other member country languages would also be an advantage.

NB. The successful applicant will be required to pass the OECD's test for statisticians.
