### Selection Criteria

- Demonstrable communications, team-building, change management and interpersonal skills;
- Recent experience of clinical practice and clinical leadership and a willingness to maintain clinical competence in midwifery.

#### Desirable

- Registration, or eligibility to register, in the Tutors' division of the register maintained by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland <u>or</u> hold an equivalent teaching and learning qualification;
- A doctoral degree or current registration for a doctoral degree;
- Evidence of dissemination of research and scholarship through research and publication;
- Knowledge of research designs, methods and techniques, and evidence of their application.
