You will be expected to work in the research project "SOLIDUS – Solidarity in European Societies: Empowerment, Social Justice and Citizenship", financed by the Horizon 2020 EU Framework Programme for Research and Innovation. A successful candidate will work on:

- conception, implementation and analysis of a standardised survey about attitudes on transnational solidarity in several EU countries
- presentation and publication of the research findings in international journals and conferences, mainly in English
- collaboration with other SOLIDUS sub-projects including administrative work

The possibility for further qualification is given.
