



## Community Engagement Manager

Canterbury Cathedral is a working church of local, national and global significance. It is the seat of the Archbishop of Canterbury and an historic pilgrimage spanning 1,400 years. The Cathedral's stunning architecture and its unique role in the nation's history have inspired generations and currently attracts more than a million visitors a year to the city of Canterbury.

The Cathedral has recently been awarded Stage 1 Heritage Lottery Funding to develop a £19.4 million project entitled, The Canterbury Journey, which will radically transform the way people access and use the Cathedral, its archive, historic collection, buildings and environs.

The project team is now seeking to appoint an enthusiastic Community Engagement Manager to support the development and delivery of the Activity Plan encompassing interpretation, learning and participation.

The successful candidate will create strong links with the Cathedral, the wider communities and partners. Applicants will need sound experience in motivating and engaging a socially and culturally diverse range of people of all learning abilities and ages through a variety of formal and informal learning activities; including outreach, events, facilitating forums, presentations, volunteer recruitment and training.

This exciting 6 year full time role will require someone who understands the community sector, and the issues affecting heritage sites and museums within this context.
