Canterbury Cathedral is a working church of local, national and global significance. It is the seat of the Archbishop of Canterbury and an historic pilgrimage spanning 1,400 years. The Cathedral's stunning architecture and its unique role in the nation's history have inspired generations and currently attracts more than a million visitors a year to the city of Canterbury.

The Cathedral has recently been awarded Stage 1 Heritage Lottery Funding to develop a £19.4 million project entitled The Canterbury Journey, which will radically transform the way people access and use the Cathedral, its archive, historic collection, buildings and environs.

The project team is now seeking to appoint an enthusiastic Collections Manager to develop, create and implement the Cathedral's Collections Management Strategy which will open up to the public existing collections. The successful candidate will be responsible for exhibiting important objects to enrich the visitor experience and interpret their surroundings.

Experienced applications will be able to research, design and curate a changing programme of public exhibitions, contribute to and progress the Digital Media Strategy, and design and deliver a supporting programme of activities including events, talks, tours and publications based around the Cathedral Collections.
