Multi-platform International Summer School on Agent-Based Modelling & Simulation for Renewable Resources Management Montpellier (France), 17-28 August 2015


Content



This summer school is about learning the different skills required for building agent-based models for renewable resources management. It is oriented towards a participatory use of models and simulation and participants will be asked to work in small groups.

During the morning sessions, the principles, methods and technics of the design, implementation and exploration stages will be collectively taught. Specific points will be addressed according to the expectations and demands of the participants. The afternoon sessions will be devoted to personal applications: the trainers will support the groups in designing, implementing and fine-tuning their own agent-based model.

Tools




Specific time slots will be allocated to teach the graphical language <u>UML</u> as well as to introduce the generic platforms <u>Cormas</u>, <u>Gama</u> and <u>NetLogo</u> by demonstrating the same benchmark model. Participants will get a chance to get a hand on each platform and then they will have to choose one to develop their model.
