## 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> June 2015

Cardiff is easily accessed from across the UK and internationally. Below are some examples of how to get to Cardiff and how to reach the conference venue.

## Rail

Cardiff Central station is accessible from most of the UK and we are lucky enough to be able to offer discount rail fares to FOCUS conference attendees thanks to First great western. To get to the conference venue in Cardiff bay, trains leave Cardiff Queen Street station every 12 minutes and take less than 5 minutes (check www.arrivatrainswales.co.uk for exact times, and last train times).

First Great Western offer Conference Fares to Cardiff Central from most of their stations and also from most stations in the London and SE area. These fares are specifically for conference delegates and may be purchased from the following weblink:

booking link for Cardiff tickets. Delegates may purchase travel in First or Standard Class, but will need to hold official conference delegate paperwork to validate the ticket if requested by a member of FGW staff.

## Car

Discounted parking is available close to the venue at Pierhead Street multi-storey car park (Pierhead Street, Cardiff CF10 4PH). The car park is open 24 hours. For discounted car parking, Wales Millenium Centre has a validator at the front desk (registration desk). All delegates will then need to produce the chip coin, which can then be validated. It can be done at any time of the day and reduces the parking down to £3.60



## Air

Cardiff Airport is approximately a 27 minute taxi ride away from Cardiff Bay. A taxi rank can be found at the arrivals terminal within the airport
