Commemorating the 50th Anniversary of Closure of the Somerset & Dorset Railway

During 2016 the Trust will mark the 50th anniversary of closure of the Somerset & Dorset Railway in March 1966. We will commemorate this much loved and lamented railway with a programme of events at sites associated with the S&D and displays and activities at our own base at Washford station on the West Somerset Railway. A travelling exhibition and associated activities will visit communities along the routes of this iconic railway from Bath to Burnham-on-Sea, Wells and Bridgwater in Somerset, and to Bournemouth and Wimborne in Dorset.

The project is supported by an Our Heritage grant from the Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF).

- This post is funded for 60 weeks and is on a fixed term contract basis.
- Part time, 21 hours per week (0.6 FTE) – working hours by agreement.
- The postholder will be required to work at weekends and during evenings as necessary to deliver the project.
- £24,000 per annum pro rata (ie £14,400 p.a.)
