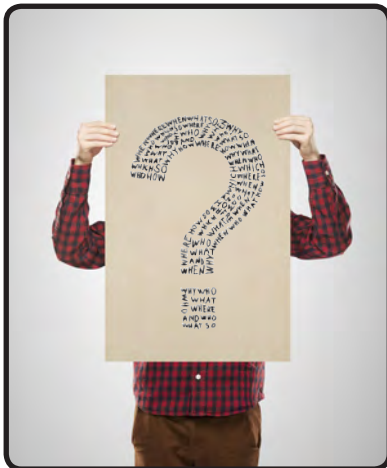

Wellcome Collection's Youth Programme is offering a group of young people with personal experience of hearing voices the chance to work with a professional artist to create an exhibit for their upcoming exhibition - 'This is a Voice'. It's a great opportunity to challenge the stigma and silence surrounding voice hearing, reaching tens of thousands of people.

The 'This is a Voice' exhibition launches in April 2016. It explores the idea of 'voice' from lots of different angles - sound, identity, body, psychology and culture. If you take part, your group piece will be on show alongside other artwork and historical objects. During the workshops, you'll also have the opportunity to create individual work that can be displayed in the Wellcome Collection's youth studio during the exhibition.

The project is free and is led by professional artist Hannah Hull, with the support of Voice Collective and Wellcome Collection's Youth Programme. Travel costs will be covered.

The series of 6 workshops will run from 11am - 5pm on Saturday 13 Feb, Friday 19 Feb, Saturday 20 Feb, Saturday 5 March, Saturday 12 March & Saturday 19 March. You will also be invited to a private view of the exhibition.
