

We are looking for a doctoral candidate in the Institute of Psychology, at the University Lübeck, Germany.

## **Doctoral Candidate (m/f)**

This DFG-funded position is available for a period of up to 3 years. The starting point is as soon as possible.

The candidate will work at a research project investigating the neural mechanisms underlying decision making in the human brain with the help of structural and functional MRI, EEG, NIRS and brain stimulation. The focus lies on economic decisions and decisions in social contexts. The research center at the University of Lübeck offers excellent state-of-the-art interdisciplinary research facilities. Furthermore, the project includes international collaborations.

Successful candidate must hold a degree (Diplom/Master) in psychology or in related fields (economics, cognitive science, biology, neuroscience or other). Experience in acquisition and analysis of human neuroimaging data (fMRI, EEG, MEG or NIRS) are desired (e.g. SPM). Programming skills in Matlab and experiences in advanced statistical analysis and in behavioral modelling will be preferred. Interest and/or experience in the field of decision neuroscience are obligatory. We are looking for a highly motivated candidate who enjoys team work and is self-organized.

The salary level will be adjusted according to the salary scheme of E13 TV-L. The conditions of this position equate 65% of a E13 TV-L position.

In order to increase the proportion of female staff members, applications from female scientists are particularly encouraged. Applicants with disabilities are preferred if qualification is equal. We explicitly ask for applications without photographs. The University of Lübeck welcomes the applications from people with a migration background.
