



Vacant position in a project on the Europeanization of social inequality in the DFG Research Unit “Horizontal Europeanization” at the University of Oldenburg

The Jean-Monnet Centre for European Studies and Transnational Regulations offers an advanced doctoral/PhD position (65%) for a researcher on income, labour market and other social inequalities (preferably on the basis of EU-SILC or LFS). The holder of the position will conduct her or his own research and qualification projects at the earliest possible date until September 30, 2018. The position is part of the DFG-FWF-funded research group “Horizontal Europeanization” (www.horizontal-europeanization.eu/de).

We invite applications from highly qualified post-graduate students. Applicants must hold a Master’s degree or equivalent qualification in the Social Sciences. A proficiency of English is essential. Candidates should pursue a PhD in one of the research fields mentioned. They are expected to support the work of the research group. The remuneration corresponds to 65 per cent of the payment group 13 of the General Framework Agreement on Public Services in the Federal States of Germany (TVL).

The University of Oldenburg is an equal opportunities employer. According to § 21 para. 3 of the legislation governing Higher Education in Lower Saxony (NHG), preference shall be given to female candidates in cases of equal qualification. The same applies to people with disabilities.
