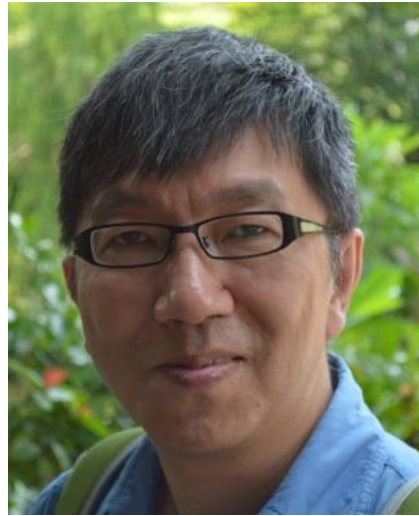


Keynote Speaker at the FinGeo First Global Seminar
