**Breaking the Chains** (2015, 64 min, Indonesia/UK/ Australia/Italy) Thousands and thousands of people worldwide live in isolation, chained, or inside "animal cages", naked, undernourished and often living in their own excrements because of mental health problems. The mental and physical consequences of these conditions are profound, including death. *Breaking the Chains* follows the activities that have been initiated in Indonesia by a group of people with mental health problems who search for and then set free other people who are victims of these practices.
