Commun.* 5:5701) and intracellular transport (see Behrmann *et al.* (2014) *JBC* 289, 33503; Arumughan *et al.* (2016) *Nat. Commun.* 7:13047), and in general principles of protein structure and interaction (see Consentius *et al.* (2016) *JACS* 138, 12868; Kang *et al.* (2016) *JACS* 138, 9108).
