Call for Papers: AJPA Volume 10 Issue 1 (September 2017)

The Raffles Dialogue invites academics and PhD students to submit manuscripts for original research articles (5,000-7,000 words excluding abstract and bibliography). The 2nd Raffles Dialogue on the Future of Human Well Being and Security (HWS) scheduled for 4-6 September 2017 in Singapore. The dialogue, titled Human Well Being and Security in 2030: The Critical Role of Innovation, aims to bring together scholars and practitioners working on critical public policy issues. Papers should preferably be related to one of the following five topics:

- 1. INNOVATIONS IN PRODUCTS AND TECHNOLOGY
- 2. INNOVATIONS IN INFORMATION
- 3. INNOVATIONS IN FINANCING OF HUMAN WELL BEING
- 4. INNOVATIONS IN MENTAL HEALTH IN AN AGEING SOCIETY & SPIRITUAL WELL BEING
- 5. INNOVATIONS IN GLOBAL GOVERNANCE

**Paper proposals should be up to 250-300 words long and include the following information: proposed title, name of author, institutional affiliation, email address and up to five keywords. We encourage academics, researchers, practitioners, post-docs, doctoral students, and post-graduate students to submit abstracts for paper presentations on above topics. Based on merit, other topics related to HWS may be considered on a case-by-case basis. Papers must not have been published previously or have been accepted or be under consideration for publication.

AJPA's Aims and Scope

Each issue features scholarly and practitioner-based research articles, field reports, commentaries, and book reviews. Articles may be quantitative and/or qualitative, national or cross-national. Preference is given to contributions which have accessible and clearly articulated policy implications.

Paper Submission:

Paper proposals should be submitted by 30 April 2017. Selection results will be out by 15 May 2017. The deadline for full paper submissions is on 1 June 2017. High quality full papers will undergo a double-blind peer review process and will be published in the September 2017 issue of AJPA (Volume 10, Issue1).





Call for Raffles Fellows:

The Raffles Dialogue invites students and young researchers from SE Asia aged 35 and below (at the time of the conference), to apply as Raffles Fellows. Up to 30 Fellowships (20 local and 10 international/regional) will be awarded. Fellows will be required to present a poster pertaining to the themes as well as participate as rapporteurs in the panel sessions during the Raffles Dialogue 2017.

Terms of Fellowship:

- Registration fees to the 2nd Raffles Dialogue 2017 will be waived for all Fellows.
- Up to 10 deserving International/Regional Fellows will receive S\$1,500 travel grant each.
- The Committee's decision is final.

- 1. The applicant must submit a paper proposal (250-300 words) as detailed in para 2 above (**).
