






Understanding our Communities in Norfolk and Suffolk


Norfolk	Norwich

BME: 3.6%	BME: 9.1%


Suffolk	Ipswich

Key recommendations:

- To improve on access of information about services.
- To improve on cultural competency skills among staff.
- To develop and implement a co-production approach between services and BME service users.
- Better communication and sufficient time to allow for a comprehensive assessment.

Some of the findings from our survey reveal:

BME respondents disagreed/strongly disagreed that **'mental** health services are culturally sensitive'





BME respondents agreed/strongly agreed with the statement: 'Instead of discussing my problems I am given a prescription'



BME respondents agreed/strongly agreed with the statement: 'I feel that I have to repeat myself each time I attend an appointment'



Of BME respondents agreed/strongly agreed that those with mental health issues 'are seen as dangerous among my circle of family and friends'


