Call for Submissions

Open Quaternary is open for submissions, looking to publish contributions that consider the changing environment of the Quaternary as well as the development of humanity. The journal focuses on all aspects of the Quaternary. The scope is intentionally broad, and covers a range of specialisms such as geomorphology, palaeoclimatology, palaeobotany, palynology, palaeontology, zooarchaeology, geoachaeology, biological anthropology and Palaeolithic archaeology.

The journal is 100% open access and fully peer-reviewed. Articles are published as soon as they are ready, post-editorial acceptance, thus ensuring authors do not experience unnecessary delay to their publication. All submissions are subjected to double blind peer-review, which has been shown to decrease gender bias in publication.

Article Processing Charges (APCs) have been kept to a minimum to ensure that the journal can sustainably operate while remaining low cost and fully open access. Fees are assessed by the publisher and are separate from the editorial and peer-review process. At £300 (\$450) the APC is just 20% of some competitors. The journal is published by Ubiquity Press and has received over 55,000 page views since its launch in 2015.
