The project contributes to the obligations by the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs (Defra) to report to the European Environment Agency. The team will use Copernicus satellite imagery from the Sentinel programme and additional spatial data sources.

Candidates are expected to hold a good honours degree or equivalent in Geography, Environmental Science or another relevant subject or demonstrate equivalent professional experience, and be familiar with satellite image interpretation, GIS and remote sensing. Team working, time management skills, and good communication skills are important.
