Purpose and Main Duties

An Associate Lecturer A is required to deliver lectures and seminars for the module 'Programming for GIS' which is a core module within our MSc in Geographic information Science, offered by the Department of Geography.

The role is to deliver weekly lectures and practical GIS sessions for one group of up to 40 students for this level 7 module in the Spring term 2018 for 3 hours per week for 07 weeks, from the 9th of January to 27th of February.

Candidate Requirements

The minimum requirements for selection are listed below:

- Postgraduate degree or equivalent;
- As a minimum at the corresponding level of award as required to teach (or equivalent professional/industry level experience).

Please note: candidates need to demonstrate competence or significant potential in all areas.

A suitable candidate should have research interests in geographic information science, knowledge of the Python programming language and the software packages ArcGIS and arcpy, and ideally some experience in teaching in Higher Education. The current teaching material will be provided, including slides and lab-based practicals.

Remuneration: Grade 7 of the College's London Pay Scale which is starting rate £58.53 per hour (inclusive of holiday pay and marking) for contact hours worked.
