

On-line External Examiner Induction

(Feedback from Bristol On Line Survey conducted in Nov 2017 via JISC External Examiner mailbase)

- 28 responses were received covering 25 different HEIs
- 6 HEIs (21%) responded as having on-line induction for External Examiners
- 11 HEIs (39%) said they were considering on-line induction for EEs
- Technologies used to support on-line induction included:
 - Skype
 - Moodle
 - Podcasts (x2)
 - Panopto Lecture Capture
 - LearningPool
 - Trinity Vision
- All respondents reported that on-line induction was pre-recorded (as opposed to being webinar/real time)
- Typical duration of on-line induction was as follows:
 - 20 mins (with links pointing to other information)
 - 24 mins (plus EE handbook link)
 - 1 hour (x3)
 - 2 hours
 - 3 hours
- Problems/difficulties with on-line induction included:
 - Issues with engagement (x3)
 - Films require updating each year
- Advantages/benefits of on-line induction included:
 - Cost saving (x3)
 - Time saving convenience – staff and EE time (x3)
 - Information always readily available for EEs to refer back to (x2)
