Abstracts should be no more than 250 words long. Please include your name, institution/organisation and title of your paper/talk. Abstracts do NOT need to be in traditional academic format. Submissions can also be made by groups of three or four people who wish to present as a panel on a particular theme – please clearly indicate on your abstract if it is to form part of panel session, including the names of co-panelists.
