Positive Behaviour Support and Active Support (Learning Disabilities)

The Care Quality Commission (CQC) are actively seeking to strengthen their team of Specialist Advisors by recruiting professionals who can demonstrate a high level of knowledge and skill in relation to the Positive Behaviour Support and Active Support within services for people with learning disabilities. We also expect applicants to hold additional training in this area.

Specialist Advisors (SpAs) are senior clinicians and professionals who assist on inspection of health and adult social care providers on an ad-hoc basis. As part of the inspection team, SpAs provide specialist advice, which helps to ensure that CQC's judgements are informed by up-to-date and credible clinical and professional knowledge and experience. The Specialist Advisor role is ad-hoc and can be carried out alongside other roles.

It is likely that applicants will be employed in roles such as specialist behaviour support teams, specialist services for people with learning disabilities or providing training, support and assessing the competency of staff in this area.
