# **CHeLabS (CULTURAL HERITAGE OPEN LABORATORY SYSTEM):**

### AN OPEN WEB PLATFORM FOR SHARING KNOWLEDGES AND EXPERIENCES

#### THE PROJECT

The National Research Council, through the collaboration of some Institutes and the partnerships at national and international level, has recently launched the **CHeLabS** (**Cultural Heritage Open Laboratory System**) project.

The project aims to promote the research and the innovation in the field of the Cultural Heritage Safeguard, through a model of territorial system, inclusive and participative, based on the principles of the Open Access and the Sharing Culture. The cultural patrimony is at the centre of this vision, in order to become the place of a dynamic process of integration among people, experiences and professionalisms. This multidisciplinary context calls for a constant dialogue between the plurality of knowledges, as for a culture of ensemble that carries dynamics generating creativity and innovation.

#### AN OPEN WEB PLATFORM FOR SHARING KNOWLEDGES AND EXPERIENCES

Today CHeLabS opens a web-based platform to start sharing knowledge and new ideas, by means of an **interactive survey**. In this phase, through a bottom-up approach, the heritage professionals and the citizens are all invited to contribute:

- The professionals are solicited to identify the needs for knowledge enhancement and for technology development, to figure out the major challenges in future researches.
- The **citizens** are involved in a participative process to identify the **heritage value** perceived by the community, and to elicit new ideas on the expected **learning experiences** inside the cultural spaces. The outcomes of this phase will configure a possible scenario, towards which the future CHeLabS structure can be oriented.

The **CHeLabS Survey** is an initiative for the **European Year of Cultural Heritage - EYCH 2018.** We address the general objective of the EYCH 2018 "Cultural heritage's contribution to the economy", through the specific objectives:

- People-centred, inclusive, forward-looking, more integrated, sustainable and cross-sectoral approaches to cultural heritage;
- Debate and research on the quality of conservation, safeguarding, innovative reuse and enhancement of cultural heritage;
- Research and innovation for cultural heritage, statistics;
- Skills and knowledge management and transfer in the cultural heritage sector;
- Research and innovation in relation to cultural heritage.
