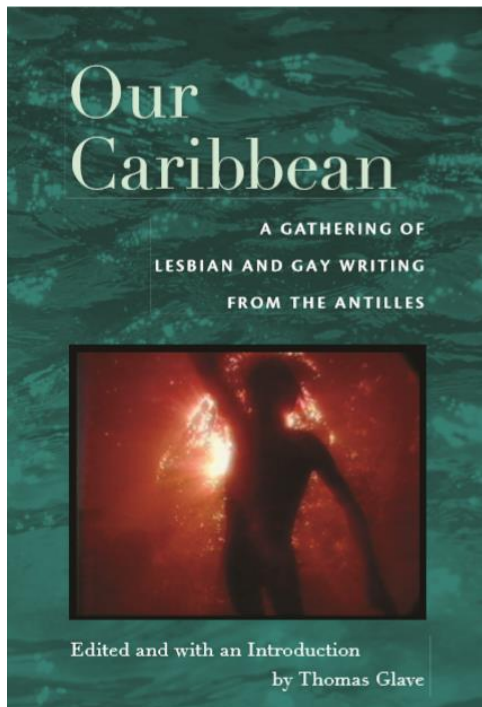
*A one-day open forum on Caribbean queerness*
