
Who is the course for?

A micro-teaching session where you plan and deliver a learning activity will be recorded and shared online with your tutor and peers, giving you valuable feedback and critical analysis to improve your practice.

Entry requirements

Falmouth University welcomes students from around the world and all applications are considered on an individual basis.

Generally, you should have:

- ☐ An honours degree or Level 6 equivalent qualification □ Proof of proficiency in English (an IELTS score of 6.5 with a minimum of 6.0 in Reading, Speaking, Writing and Listening or equivalent) if English isn't your first
- ☐ As a guideline, we expect applicants to be actively engaged in supporting student learning in HE for a minimum of 50 hours over the course's duration - and be able to give evidence of this.

If you don't have a degree, but you have relevant work experience, you may still be eligible to apply. Please contact us at: flexible@falmouth.ac.uk to check your eligibility.

To apply for Falmouth University's flexible PGCHE course, simply follow these steps:



- 2. Submit a copy of your degree certificate or Level 6 equivalent qualification and your IELTS certificate if English isn't your first language
- 3. Within your application you will be expected to demonstrate sufficient previous and current practice in supporting student learning in Higher Education (HE).

Once you've received an offer letter, you'll need to pay a non-refundable acceptance fee of £200 to secure your place. This must be received within 2 weeks of the offer letter date.
