Job description

TransAge project

'Transnational Ageing among Older Migrants and Natives: A Strategy to Overcome Vulnerability' is a project financed by the Swiss National Science Foundation and led by Prof. Ruxandra Oana Ciobanu at the Centre for the Interdisciplinary Study of Gerontology and Vulnerability and the Institute of Demography and Socioeconomics, University of Geneva.

TransAge will develop a better understanding of transnational practices to overcome vulnerability in old age by doing an innovative comparison between older international migrants, internal migrants and natives. The project will use a mixed-methods research design.

Research activity

The objective is to underpin the factors contributing to vulnerability in old age and compare older natives and migrants in Switzerland and Italy in terms of vulnerability and transnational practices.

Relying on primary and secondary data analysis, the candidate will study the factors contributing to or hindering vulnerability in old age, and compare older natives and migrants in Switzerland and Italy. Aside from quantitative analysis, s/he will co-elaborate the questionnaire and co-supervise the data collection process (to be sub-contracted).

Requirements

Profile of the ideal candidate:

- PhD in Social sciences (e.g. Sociology, Social statistics, Socioeconomics, Demography)
- Strong statistical expertise in longitudinal data analysis (sequence analysis, ...)
- Expertise in the analysis of large-scale longitudinal datasets
- Good knowledge of SPSS, Stata and / or R







- An interest in migration / mobility and gerontology
- Fluency in English, spoken and written, French is a plus
- Good research and publication record relative to the career stage
- Organisational and presentation skills
- Being interested to work in a team and in an interdisciplinary and international environment

Tasks expected from the Postdoc candidate

- Analyse several databases
- Publications in international peer-reviewed journals
- Development of research materials (e.g. questionnaire)
- Participate to the co-supervision of a data collection that will be sub-contracted
- Participate to the co-supervision of MA students
- Participate in administrative tasks in relation to the research project (e.g. conference organisation)
- Present research results in national and international conferences
