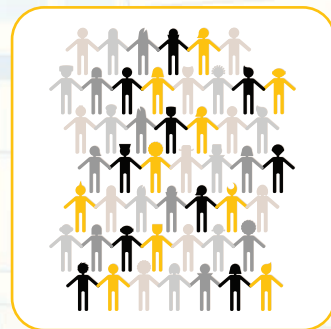
Our team comprises teachers, school leaders, and administrators and is guided by a distinguished panel of experts.
