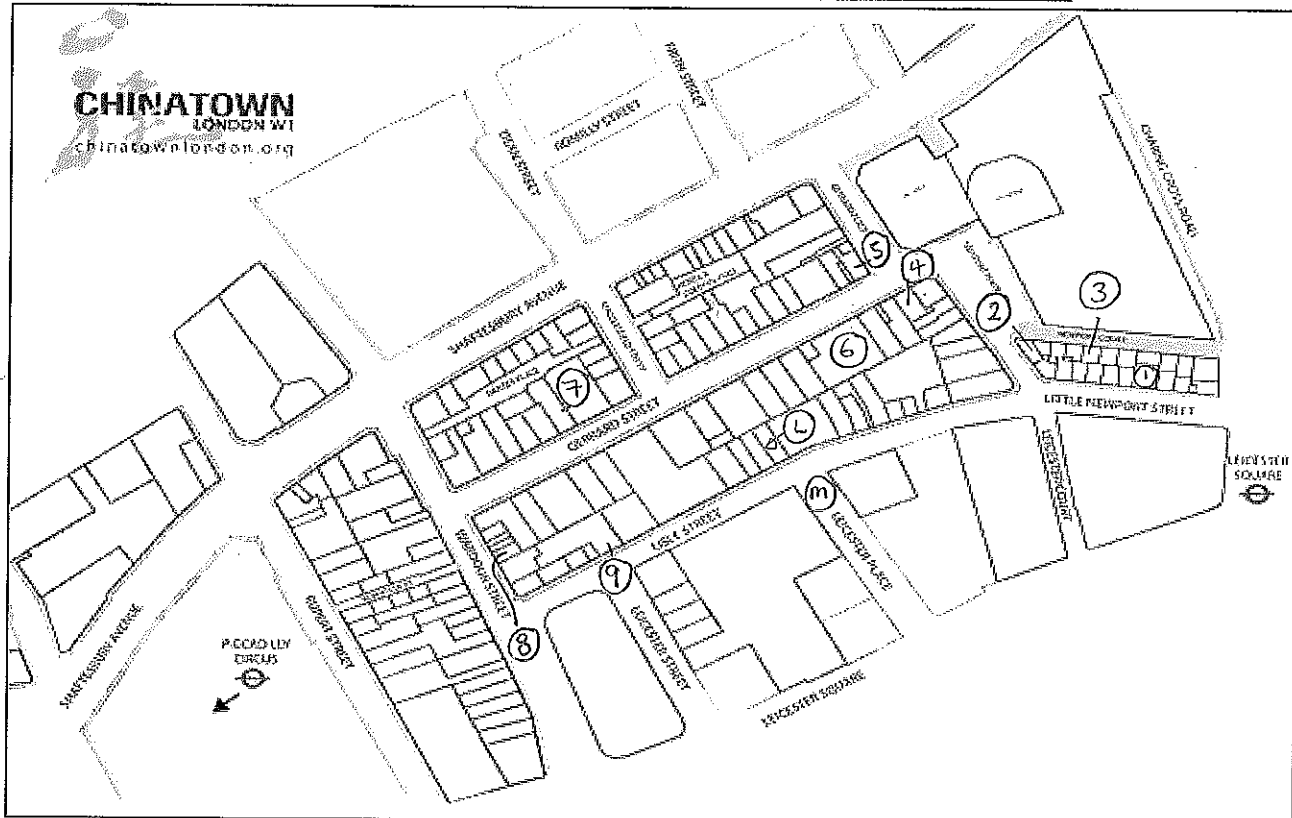

## CHINA TOWN TRIP – MAP & TREASURE HUNT!



1. It is nearly New Year so keep an eye out for all the red 'papercut' signs. Note down the characters for Happy New Year.
2. Also see if you can spot an upside down 'fu' which denotes good luck. Write down where you saw it. You can mark it on the map if that is easier.
3. Write down the character for tea – you can find it on shops 1 & 2 on the map.
4. What is the specialty of the 珍 Café (2 on the map) – other than tea. Write it in characters as well as English.
5. The Baozi Inn at 3 on the map has a sign with six characters. Can you work out which two mean London?
6. Number 4 on the map is a restaurant that advertises 'home made delicacies'. Can you find the characters for that phrase?
7. Number 5 on the map is a restaurant called Wan Chai corner. Can you find the characters for 'dim sum' and 'small snacks'?
8. Number 6 on the map is a supermarket – can you find the characters for supermarket?
8. Number 7 is the HSBC bank. Can you guess the characters for 'bank' from its sign? Write them!
9. Number 8 is a currency exchange. The word for the Chinese currency is 'ren min bi'. Can you find the characters for this word?
10. Number 9 is Express Telecom. Using its sign, note down the character for 'electric' as found in 'phone/television/film' etc. (This is the 'complex' character)
