LIK SUEN 宣力	is now Principal Lecturer in Chinese at SOAS, University of London, and the Executive Director of the London Confucius Institute, SOAS. She was the chief examiner in Chinese for a leading UK examining board. She has experience in teaching Chinese in China, Hong Kong, US and UK from beginner to Master's degree level. Her research interests are Chinese phonology and syntax, Chinese dialects, language testing and teaching Chinese at schools.
QIAN KAN 阚茜	is Senior Lecturer in Chinese and Head of Chinese in the School of Languages and Applied Linguistics at The Open University. She is senior fellow of the British Higher Education Academy and affiliated with the University of Cambridge as Director of Studies in Asian and Middle Eastern Studies. She is an experienced author of Chinese language teaching and learning materials. Her publication includes the well-known Chinese language textbooks <i>Developing</i> <i>Writing Skills in Chinese</i> and <i>Colloquial Chinese</i> .
ALICE WEBB	is Head of Mandarin at Benenden School. She is an experienced Chinese teaching practitioner having worked extensively in both state comprehensive and grammar schools as well as schools in the private sector. She is a chief examiner in Chinese for a leading UK examining board including developing GCSE examination specifications and writing GCSE papers, together with conducting teacher-training sessions commissioned by the exam board.
HUA YAN 晏华	is Head of Mandarin at Northwood College. He is an very experienced Chinese teaching practitioner. He is also the author of well-known Chinese language textbook, <i>Edexcel GCSE (9-1) Chinese</i> .
