ZHANG**

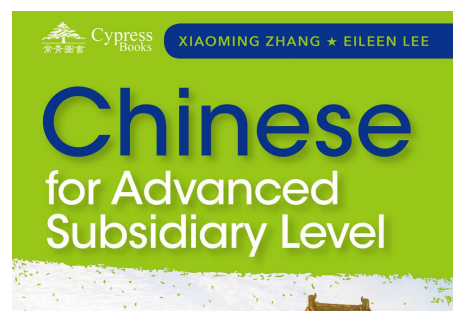
