The development of sustainable, energy-saving artefacts and techniques requires the inseparability of active images, spaces and materials through an interdisciplinary approach in which the humanities, natural sciences and design disciplines cooperate as equal partners. Experimental and design-oriented approaches will be combined with historical analysis in order to draw practical and theoretical consequences. For the initial six research projects, the participating Principal Investigators from over 40 disciplines are seeking outstanding young researchers to collaboratively investigate the practices of »Weaving«, »Cutting«, »Filtering«, the structural connections of »Material Form Function« and »Object Space Agency« as well as the codes of »Symbolic Material«.

<u>Requirements:</u> completed academic education and PhD in a subject relevant to the respective project, interdisciplinary research experience and excellent English skills, both written and spoken. Designers without a doctorate are invited to apply if they have several years of practical and/or research experience. In special cases, candidates with doctoral projects (e.g. mathematics, computer science) are also welcome to apply.
