

## Realist Synthesis Masterclass

The 3-day Realist Synthesis Masterclass is a specialized training course for applying realist methodology principles to the task of literature review. The programme will include a range of activities including didactic sessions, group work and one-on-one consultations. Topics to be addressed include:

- How to establish programme and middle-range theories suitable for literature review;
- How to guide decisions about the scope of data sources to be included;
- How to read and code papers;
- How to use data sources to construct context-mechanism-outcome configurations;
- How to establish a rigorous, transparent and retroductive line of analysis;
- How to conduct a rapid realist synthesis;
- How to use realist synthesis for programme development;
- How to convey findings from a realist synthesis.

There will be time for participants to discuss on-going questions and challenges, as well as networking. Lunch and refreshments will be provided.
