Paper presentations (in English or German) should be no more than 20 minutes in length with 5 minutes for questions or a short discussion. Workshops (in English or German) should last 45 minutes.

Papers

The authors of accepted abstracts will be invited to submit their full papers to be published in the post-conference proceedings. The deadline for full paper submission is **15 October 2020**.
