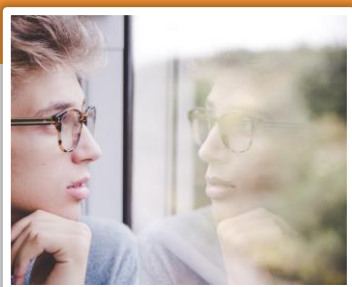


INTERCULTURAL REFLECTION ON TEACHING

The Project

Intercultural Reflection on Teaching (IntRef) is funded by Erasmus+ and stimulates reflective dialogue between colleagues from different countries, institutions, and disciplines, facilitated through technology.

The Methods

Intercultural Reflecting Team: A transnational group of academics share problems arising from their teaching, facilitated by video-conferencing. The provider of the problem learns by observing others discuss possible solutions to their problem.

Intercultural Teaching Process Recall: A transnational group of academics share extracts from videos of the teaching, facilitated by video-conferencing. Each 'recaller' explores their actions, thoughts and feelings through questions asked by other members of the group.

Intercultural Peer Observation: Academics form transnational pairs in which videos of their teaching are discussed in one-to-one synchronous virtual chat.

This free interactive workshop will offer hands-on experience of the innovative reflective methods developed by the project, step-by-step guidance on implementing them in your home institution, access to practical resources that support their implementation, and networking opportunities.
