In the first part of this online workshop, **Elizabeth Chin** will provide practical tips about how to publish a peer reviewed article in a high impact journal, such as American Anthropologist.

In the second part, **Ian M. Cook** will talk about the process of reviewing, an academic practice that has received far less attention than publishing, yet is equally vital for a healthy and thriving academic community.

By treating publishing and reviewing as connected, this workshop emphasises that both academic practices require experience, skills, and care. A good publishing experience is inseparable from a generous and well-formulated review. Therefore, if academics wish to contribute to a productive peer-review process, they need to not only learn to become effective writers, but also acquire skills on how to become careful, reflexive, and effective reviewers.
