

THE CHALLENGE OF CHINA

Tuesday 3rd October 2023 From 9.00a.m. to 12.00p.m.

This challenge is a VIRTUAL event and will be presented using Zoom.

The Challenge of China is specially aimed at students who have been learning Mandarin Chinese for about 2 – 3 years. It will help them appreciate the value of China in the global economy and learning Chinese through a business challenge.





Overview

China is a rapidly growing economy. There are more native speakers of Chinese than any other language and currently Chinese is the second most used language on the internet. The UK is rapidly expanding its business interests over there and for our business to grow and prosper it is vital that we understand its people and its culture.

This is an opportunity for your language students to practise their Mandarin in a business setting. They will pit their wits against other students from around the UK who are also learning Mandarin.

Outline of the morning

The day will include:

- A keynote talk on business in China
- A business challenge for which there will be prizes for the winners
- Tasks in Chinese which will also practise employability skills

Who can take part?

You are invited to submit one or more teams of 5 or 6 students learning Chinese. They may be of any secondary age, though we are expecting that most will be in the Year 9 – Year 12 range. We would like them to have been studying Mandarin Chinese for 2 - 3 years.
